WHERE? - Paris, FRANCE

WHEN? 27th June 2020 - 7th july 2020 / APV Mars - April 2020

WHO? 4 young people (18-30) + 1 youth leader per country





1. The Project

Art is among the most powerful tools of expression. Regardless of who you are, what you want where you come from, your background or education, art is a means with which you can express yourself and communicate with other people, breaking the barriers of language and cultural differences.

The idea is to create a sharing space in during 9 days, where young people from different European countries can exchange their ideas and opinions, have a constructive dialogue, learn more about and practice different kinds of arts and work together to present a common result in the end of the exchange for the local people.

This youth exchange will give an opportunity to the participant to become an active actor of the society. The teacher will become the student, and the student will become the teacher.

Through this project, we hope to develop and provide new tools to young people that already have some experience in art, but also to youngsters who, although they don't have experience in art, wish to learn about the arts.

This Youth Exchange will be connected with the urban art, and the Hip-hop Culture. The final show will be in link with urban festival "Block Party" (Concert, Graffiti, Dance Battle..)





2. Objectives

- To promote active participation of the participants, free expression, intercultural Learning
- Introduce young people to non-formal learning
- Involve local communities
- Give opportunities to the young people to find new ways of expressing -which they can apply in their local communities
- To promote European citizenship
- To use new ways of learning
- To promote non-formal education values
- To create a network between the participants
- To give them the opportunity to express their creativity
- To break the stereotype, and fight the racism.

Finally, thought the activities of this exchange and the preparation of the final event/presentation, the participants will gain some organizational and project management skills

3. Methodology

We will use process of the non formal learning, peer to peer, presentations, learning from experience, discussions, artistic workshops, sharing of skills and experiences.

The participant will learn in each discipline by some professional teacher and the others participants

The participant will share their experiences in different art. We want the participant be involved in the learning process, and they will acquire skills how to teach their art to the other.





4. Profile of participant

Participants: 4 participants per country, 18 - 30 years old + 1 youth leader per country (no age limit)

We need participants with experience in DANCE (all kind of dance, but the final project will be in link of urban dance) related as well as youth with fewer opportunities (ideally combining the groups in order to achieve peer learning outcomes and motivation for youth with fewer opportunities)

All participants need to be willing to share their skills, learn new things, and work together for the creation of a common result.

As we want our partners to be involved in this Youth Exchange as much as possible, ideally Youth leaders should have experience in music, or related arts (dance, musical theatre, etc) and/or non- formal education and be able to lead a workshop about them.

Selection of Youth Leaders: by the end of January 2020

Collection of profiles of interested participants: February 2020

APV: March / April 2020

Final Selection of Participants: During the APV Youth Exchange: 27th of june – 7th of July 2020

7. Financial
